



IBUS Module 1 Workshop Goals

One of the goals of this workshop is to **learn the basics of ultrasound application in IBD**.

The participants will learn how to:

- **Set up** the ultrasound machine
- Find and describe normal bowel findings
- Find and describe mural and extramural findings including complications such as fistula and abscess as well as bowel findings other than IBD
- Interpret post-operative findings
- Find and describe **perianal** findings, including fistula and abscess
