


IUS in IBD: Start next week back home


- Define short and long term goals

- How to extend knowledge, pick the right colleagues






IUS clinic setup Leuven

This IBUS Hybrid Workshop is open to Physicians with IUS experience who would like to obtain IBUS Certification.

Eligibility Criteria & Submission Requirements:

- Performed a minimum of 300 exams over the last 3 years
- Submit a certified letter from the head of the department confirming the candidate's experience and expertise (if part of a medical department) or motivational letter (if part of a private practice)
- IBUS member in good standing



In 2024, **IBUS** successfully launched an educational program to train future gastroenterologists, IBD nurse specialists, radiologists, and sonographers in IUS.

To date, over 300 are taking part in or have completed the course.

Over the next three years, this project will equip participants with comprehensive IUS training tools to enhance the non-invasive, point-of-care management of IBD. Funded by **The Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust**, the program utilizes an **eLearning platform** developed by **Motilent**, experts in innovative medical imaging.
